Policy on Burial of Non-residents Effective from 1 April 2019 Bishop's Itchington Cemetery

Eligibility

To be eligible for burial in Bishop's Itchington Cemetery, a person who is not habitually resident in the parish of Bishop's Itchington at the date of their death, must satisfy **one** of the following conditions:

- 1. They must already own the exclusive right of burial in an existing plot in the cemetery (subject to verification of a valid deed of grant).
- 2. They were previously resident in the parish for a minimum period of 15 years at some time during their life.
- 3. They were resident in the parish until either
 - i they were admitted to hospital, or
 - ii they entered residential care or sheltered accommodation, or
 - they went to live with relatives or friends who are providing long term care for them owing to age or infirmity

Fees Payable

Conditions 1 & 2

The fees payable in respect of non-residents who are eligible for burial by virtue of either condition 1 or 2 as stated above, shall be twice the standard fees payable at their date of death, except where the death occurred within 6 months of the date they left the parish in which case the standard fees will apply as normal.

Condition 3

The standard fees will apply in respect of non-residents who are eligible for burial by virtue of condition 3 as stated above.
